



Best practices

As a community of volunteers, we strive to create a respectful, safe, and inspiring environment for every child and member. To ensure this, we encourage all volunteers to follow these best practices:

Attendance and Commitment

- Volunteers are expected to maintain at least 85% attendance during teaching sessions. In case of absence, please give prior notice so that necessary arrangements can be made.
- Everyone is encouraged to be punctual and respect the scheduled time for sessions.

Professional Conduct

- All volunteers are expected to treat students with care, patience, and respect. There will be zero tolerance for yelling, harsh language, or corporal punishment.
- Volunteers are requested to avoid personal conversations or sharing personal details (such as phone numbers or social media handles) with students. This helps maintain professional boundaries.
- Respect for fellow volunteers is essential—mutual support and collaboration are at the heart of our work.

Use of Devices and Communication

- Mobile phones should not be used during teaching sessions. In case of an emergency, please step outside the classroom to attend calls.

Dress and Presentation

- Volunteers are requested to wear simple, modest attire during sessions. Avoid extravagant clothing, expensive accessories, or anything that may distract from the learning environment.
